# HOW TO GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR BIBLE READING?

## S. O. A. P.

**S**cripture: Take time to read and allow God to speak to you. Highlight, underline or mark in the margin of your Bible next to verses that stand out. When you are done reading the entire passage, reread the verses you marked, choose one that speaks to you that day. Write out your scripture verse.

**O**bservation: What do you think God is saying to you in this verse? Ask God to teach you and reveal Himself to you as you read. Paraphrase this scripture in your own words and write it down.

**A**pplication: Ask yourself how it applies to your life right now. Perhaps it is instruction, encouragement, revelation of a new promise, or correction for a specific area of your life. Write down how this scripture can apply to you today.

**P**ray: Bring your time to a close with prayer. This can be as simple as asking God to help you use this scripture or asking for greater insight on what He may be revealing to you. Remember, prayer is a two-way conversation, so be sure to listen to what God has to say! What are you praying for? What is God saying in response to your prayer?



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
